### **Marten Transport to receive tax credits**

Wisconsin Governor Jim Doyle this week announced that Mondovi-based Marten Transport Ltd. will receive \$250,000 in Agricultural Development Zone tax credits from the Department of Commerce to assist the trucking firm with the \$1 million expansion of its corporate headquarters.

Last week, Marten announced that it had completed an 11,000-square-foot expansion of its headquarters facility. The announcement from the state will result in the creation of 162 full-time positions and the retention of 337 jobs.

"As part of this expansion, we included state-of-the-art technology for our telephone system, capacity/demand balancing and more effective internal communication," said Marten Transport Chief Operating Officer Bob Smith.

Marten Transport, a publicly-owned supplier of time and temperature-sensitive transportation services throughout North America, has four terminals, including its newest terminal facility in Indiana-polis, IN. *TBL*
