



WHEN APPROACHING ANY INTERSECTION...

 Aim high in steering - be looking 15 seconds in front of you.

CRITICALLY IMPORTANT

- NEVER speed up to beat a light.
- Be mindful of oncoming traffic turning left in front of you.
- Look ahead to judge timing - aim high in steering.

STALE GREEN LIGHTS

- Lights that you did not witness changing to green.
- Lights that have been green for some time.
- Slow down to anticipate a yellow light.



YELLOW LIGHTS

Begin to slow down, prepare to stop; the light will soon turn red.

STOP SIGN INTERSECTIONS

- Come to a complete stop - ZERO miles per hour.
- Confirm traffic has cleared before proceeding.

STOPLIGHT INTERSECTIONS

- Come to a complete stop - ZERO miles per hour.
- Proceed only after the light has turned green and traffic has cleared.
- Coming to a complete stop is still required when making right turns!
